

5 Sample Questions

1. What 1939 children's poem introduced Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer?

Answer: "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" by Robert L. May, written for the Montgomery Ward department store as a holiday giveaway.

2. In Home Alone, what brand of aftershave does Kevin scream after applying?

Answer: Trick question — the original 1990 film doesn't name the brand. Kevin just slaps it on. Movie quizzes who claim it's "Old Spice" are wrong.

3. Mariah Carey's "All I Want for Christmas Is You" was released in what year?

Answer: 1994. It took 25 years to finally hit #1 on the Billboard Hot 100, in December 2019.

4. Which country eats KFC as a Christmas dinner tradition?

Answer: Japan. The custom started with a 1974 KFC marketing campaign called "Kurisumasu ni wa Kentakkii" (Kentucky for Christmas).

5. In It's a Wonderful Life, what does George Bailey wish he'd never been?

Answer: Born. The angel Clarence shows him what Bedford Falls would look like without him.
